
This second co-funded call aims to support transnational research and innovation projects for 36 months.

26 Countries, 38 PFOs responsible for funding R&I actions in the blue economy combined with the contribution from the European Union.

How does the call works?

- Financial resources from 38 PFOs
- Co-funding from the EU

- Two-step submission procedure (pre-proposal and full-proposal)
- One single International Evaluation Committee (IEC) + independent observer + observer from the Decade Coordination Unit

- One single ranking list
- Funding the highest-ranked projects
